

Restricted Vision video transcript

Hi, I'm Sarah from Vodafone and I've got some tips to help you get the most out of your phone or tablet if you're blind or have restricted vision.

First of all, you can adjust the font size on your phone. You'll usually find this option in Settings. Some phones let you adjust the brightness, colours and contrast to make reading the screen easier.

Many phones now have Voice Control, like Siri on Apple or S-Voice on Samsung. Use the dedicated button and you can tell your phone to do something.

Phone: Calling Sam

There are also really useful apps like Mobile Accessibility and Big Launcher on Google Play, which can help you to navigate your phone. Zoom Plus Video magnifier is another one, which turn your phone into an adaptable magnifying glass.

And at Vodafone we can arrange to have your bill sent to you in Braille. Call 33222 from your Vodafone phone and we'll set it up.
