## Mouse and keyboard adjustments for Windows

With Windows Vista and Windows 7 you can slow down the speed of your mouse, make it easier to use if you're left handed, and slow down the double click speed.

- Tap the Windows key at the bottom left corner of the page
- Type Ease of Access Center into the search bar at the bottom left corner of the start menu and press Enter
- Choose Make the mouse easier to use

If you want to use your keyboard to control your mouse:

- Click on the Start button at the bottom left corner of the page
- Choose the Ease of Access Center
- Choose Make the keyboard easier to use

With Windows 8, 8.1 and 10, Ease of Access options are available in Settings. Click the Start button, choose Settings, followed by Ease of Access, and then choose the access option which makes it easier for you to:

- Use your PC without a display. The narrator lets you hear audio descriptions for elements on the screen, such as text and buttons
- See what's on the screen. Make the content on your screen bigger using Magnifier, or use the high contrast mode
- Use your keyboard. Turn on sticky keys, toggle keys, filter keys, or the on-screen keyboard
- Use your mouse. Change the pointer size, or turn on the mouse keys to use your keypad to move the mouse

## Mouse and keyboard adjustments for Mac OSX

To change the speed of your mouse:

- Open System Preferences from the Apple icon
- Open the Universal Access pane
- Choose the Mouse tab

To control your mouse using your keyboard:

- Open the System Preferences from the Apple icon
- Open the Universal Access pane
- Choose the Keyboard tab
