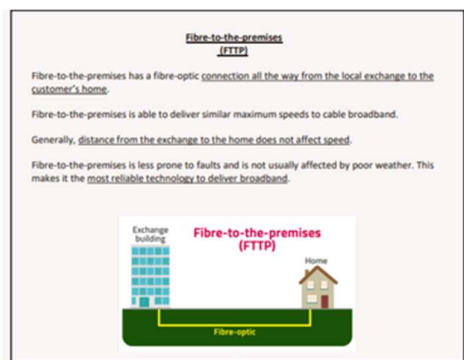

### Same broadband for less/we use the same technology

Vodafone Fibre 1 and Fibre 2 use Openreach SOGEA. BT, EE and Sky also use Openreach SOGEA to deliver their comparable HBB products. SOGEA, (Single Order Generic Ethernet Access) is provided by Openreach and is defined as partial fibre broadband using fibre from the exchange to the nearest street cabinet and then copper pair from the street cabinet to the home. Download speeds of up to 80Mbps can be achieved depending on the distance from the street cabinet and the quality of the wiring in the customer premise. SOGEA is provided with a VoIP telephone line provided by Vodafone (and in BT's case, by BT) that utilises the broadband connectivity.

Given that Vodafone, BT, EE, and Sky all the SOGEA for their comparable product, it is therefore the same type of broadband technology.

Vodafone Full Fibre 2, 100, 500 and 910 use Openreach FTTP. BT, EE and Sky also use Openreach FTTP to deliver their comparable HBB products.
