

Updated statement – March 10 2011

Response to claims of Vodafone website ‘hack’

Following an investigation, and contrary to some online media reports, we can confirm that there was no ‘hack’ of our World of Difference web site today. The posts which appeared on two World of Difference winners’ blogs, were published as a result of an individual sharing log in details with a protest group, not as a result of a ‘hack’.

There was no risk to World of Difference winners, or Vodafone customers’ personal data at any time. World of Difference winners are doing great things for charities up and down the country. It’s very sad to see how low people will go to further spread misinformation and for the charitable programme to be used as a platform for this kind of protest.
