

Emergency Home Worker Plan & Emergency Data Bundles

This Price Plan Guide applies to the Vodafone Emergency Home Worker Plan & Emergency Data Bundles and is incorporated into the Commercial Terms between Vodafone and Customer and, together with the General Terms and Mobile Service Terms, shall form the Agreement for the Vodafone Emergency Home Worker Plan & Emergency Data Bundles. All Charges exclude VAT.

1. Emergency Home Worker Plan and Emergency Data Bundles Conditions for plans taken after the 12th May 2020:

The Emergency Home Worker Plan and Emergency Data Bundles "Emergency Products" are only available:

- to an existing Vodafone Customer;
- on a 30 day rolling contract; and
- for the number of FTE employees of the Customer, minus any existing Vodafone connection(s).

The charge for the Emergency Products will be added to the Customer's monthly bill.

Vodafone reserves the right to terminate the Emergency Products at any point. Vodafone will give the Customer 30 days' notice prior to terminating the Emergency Products.

Customer may terminate the Emergency Products at any time by serving notice to Vodafone in accordance with the General Terms.

Where a Customer or Vodafone terminates, the Customer will be charged a prorated amount for the number of days from the date of the Customer's last bill, to the date of termination including any out of bundle charges.

Upon termination of the connection by Vodafone, or Customer, Customer can request that the Emergency Home Worker Plan be upgraded to an alternative standard Vodafone Price Plan by paying the applicable charge, and accepting the applicable terms and conditions.

In Rest of World Zones 1,2,3,4 we will charge you for the call you make in one minute increments with a one-minute minimum call charge. For receiving calls, we will charge you in increments (depending on your agreement) with a minimum call charge.

Premium rate and satellite calls are excluded and additional charges (including network handling fees) may apply.

If we are charged an admin fee from a foreign network operator for you to receive a text, we will pass this charge to you. Roaming services may be available to you from other providers.

Inclusive Roaming Fair Usage Policy

If you have one of our Unlimited plans, data usage when roaming is capped at 25GB per billing month in Roam-free and Roam further destinations. We will notify you as you approach this limit. If you reach this limit, you will need to purchase an additional data bundle to continue using data in a Roam-free or Roam-further destination until your monthly allowance renews. Please go to <u>http://www.vodafone.co.uk/travelling</u> for details of our additional data bundles. Any unused data on additional data bundles you have purchased will expire at the end of your billing period. Roam-free, Roam-further Europe Zone 1 and 2 are intended for periodic travel and not for users roaming on a semi-permanent or permanent basis.

If customers use their mobile in our Europe Zone 1 and 2 for more than 50% of the time in any 4 month rolling period, they will receive a text requesting more moderate use of our roaming services.

If customers' usage in our inclusive Europe Zone 1 and 2 continues to exceed 50% as described above, over the 2-week period following the first notification, customers may be charged for further use or we may bar them from using our roaming services. Customers will be notified before we do this.

3. Emergency Data Bundles: Emergency Shared Data Bundles

Opt in Options for Using Data in the UK:

Emergency Shared Data Bundles can be added together (e.g. 1GB and 3GB added together will give a data bundle of 4GB). Customer cannot add two of the same bundles together (e.g. 1GB and 1GB).

The Emergency Shared Data Bundles can be used while roaming if opted in Business Traveller, Public Sector Traveller, Eurotraveller and World Traveller.
